HIGH RISE LITTERING / KILLER LITTER

We have received several feedback from fellow occupants on high rise littering.

The items found include, amongst other things, cigarette butts which is a major fire hazard concern.

Especially here in High Street Centre where level 6, the podium roof, is actually a garden office floor with many offices and occupants. As such, littering out of your windows can cause potential damage and bodily harm, not to mention fire in the case of cigarettes butts.

Please be advised that high rise littering in Singapore is **PUNISHABLE BY LAW**, the penalties of which include substantial fines as well as **Corrective Work Order**.

There have been published cases on penalties for throwing plastic bags and cigarette butts out of windows, with the highest fine recorded at **\$19,800**.

Please be advised that the Management takes a very serious stance on this issue and we will not hesitate to refer offenders to the authorities.


For the safety of all at High Street Centre, we seek your cooperation to refrain from high rise littering.
